



Expectations and responsibilities of international students

Conditions of your Student Visa

It is the responsibility of all international students holding a Student Visa to know and abide by the conditions of their Student Visa as set by the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC). You must:

- Complete your program within the duration of your visa;
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress by attending class and meeting prescribed course requirements;
- Not interrupt your study, except for compelling or compassionate grounds;
- Apply for a 'Student Visa with Permission to Work', if you wish to work. Please note that restrictions apply. For more information please visit:

- Maintain Overseas Student Health Cover for the duration of your studies
- Advise AIM immediately of changes in your Australian address and contact details.
