SHORT COURSES 2019

AIM Short Courses are a great way to further your knowledge in the world of music, production, composition and performance.

Our courses cater from the beginner all the way through to those with existing experience keen to enhance their skills and knowledge.

No matter what your interest is in the world of music and creative arts, AIM has you covered. In 2019 our new consolidated Short Course programs will cover music/vocal performance techniques, music production, electronic music techniques and tools, composition, music theory as well as theatre techniques!

All courses are of ten weeks duration and feature group work as well as individual guidance from our highly experienced teachers and mentors. You'll get the chance to put your newfound knowledge to the test at the end of each course with a performance, demonstration or practical session that can showcase your skills and progress.

Many students go on to undertake further advanced studies following completion of our short courses. Our revised range of courses for 2019 are designed to provide prerequisites and facilitate early entry or conditional offers into some of our renowned bachelor degree programs at AIM.

The below summary contains brief course descriptions, location and dates for 2019, and what previous short course program from AIM the new course new relates to.

MUSIC PRODUCTION – THE HOME STUDIO

DESCRIPTION

This course focuses on teaching students how to set up a home studio. Students will learn basics of home studio design, tools and operation. By the end of the course, they will have recorded either their own original work or a work by their peers.

On completion those students wishing to undertake further studies in this field may have the opportunity to receive a conditional offer into our popular Bachelor of Music (Composition and Music Production), or Bachelor of Music (Audio) undergraduate degree programs.*

Music Production- The Home Studio is offered in Study Period 2, 2019 – running for 10 weeks from Monday, May 27th 2019 at both AIM Melbourne and Sydney campuses.

ELECTRONIC MUSIC

DESCRIPTION

In this course, students will cover composition, basics of contemporary DJ techniques, and be able to produce music in at least one digital audio workstation.

Electronic Music is a consolidated course from previous short courses offered at AIM:

DJ, Hip Hop Artist, Ableton, Logic and ProTools

This course can cater for the beginner electronic artist/producer as well as those students seeking early entry into our popular Bachelor of Music (Composition and Music Production) undergraduate degree program at AIM*.

Electronic Music is offered in Study Period 2, 2019 – running for 10 weeks from Monday, May 27th 2019 at both AIM Melbourne and Sydney campuses.

COMPOSITION

DESCRIPTION

This course can cater for the beginner composer/songwriter or for the student seeking early entry into the associated undergraduate degree

Students will receive an overview of composition/songwriting techniques. They will also have the opportunity to develop their own original composition/song by the end of the course to be performed, or to demonstrate their involvement in the produced recording.

Composition is a consolidated course from these previous Short Courses offered at AIM: Songwriting Foundations, Music Production for the Songwriter as well as Pro Tools.

This course may offer opportunities for early entry into our popular Bachelor of Music (Composition) and Bachelor of Music (Contemporary) undergraduate degree programs at AIM*.

Composition is offered in Study Period 3, 2019 – running for 10 weeks from Monday, September 9th 2019 at both AIM Melbourne and Sydney campuses.

MUSIC INDUSTRY

DESCRIPTION

Music Industry is an introduction to key areas of the Music Business industry. Students will learn about areas such as: Artist Management, Music Publishing, Promotion/Publicity/Marketing, Law & Copyright and more.

A working visit to an operating music industry business is offered as part of the course program.

On completion those students wishing to undertake further studies in this field will have the opportunity to receive a conditional offer in our esteemed Bachelor of Entertainment Management degree program*.

Music Industry is a revised course from the previous Music Business 101 short course offered at AIM.

Music Industry is offered in Study Period 3, 2018 – running for 10 weeks from Monday, September 9th 2019 at both AIM Melbourne and Sydney campuses.

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
